The Orleans County Natural Resource Conservation District (OCNRCD) is providing a cost sharing service to help restore the shoreline buffer zones on private property. They will create a planting plan with you and provide all native plants, if the landowner will install them and agree not to cut or remove them for 10 years. The landowner only pays 20% of the plant cost, that would typically not exceed \$40, and the installation is free. There is a broad variety of native plants to choose from and planting designs can have many configurations to fit your land.

The OCNRCD is also conducting a native plant sale and has an excellent catalog of bare root stock native plants and berries. Ask Dayna for the catalog and pricing but all plants must be ordered by March 31 and picked up in Newport on May 8th.
